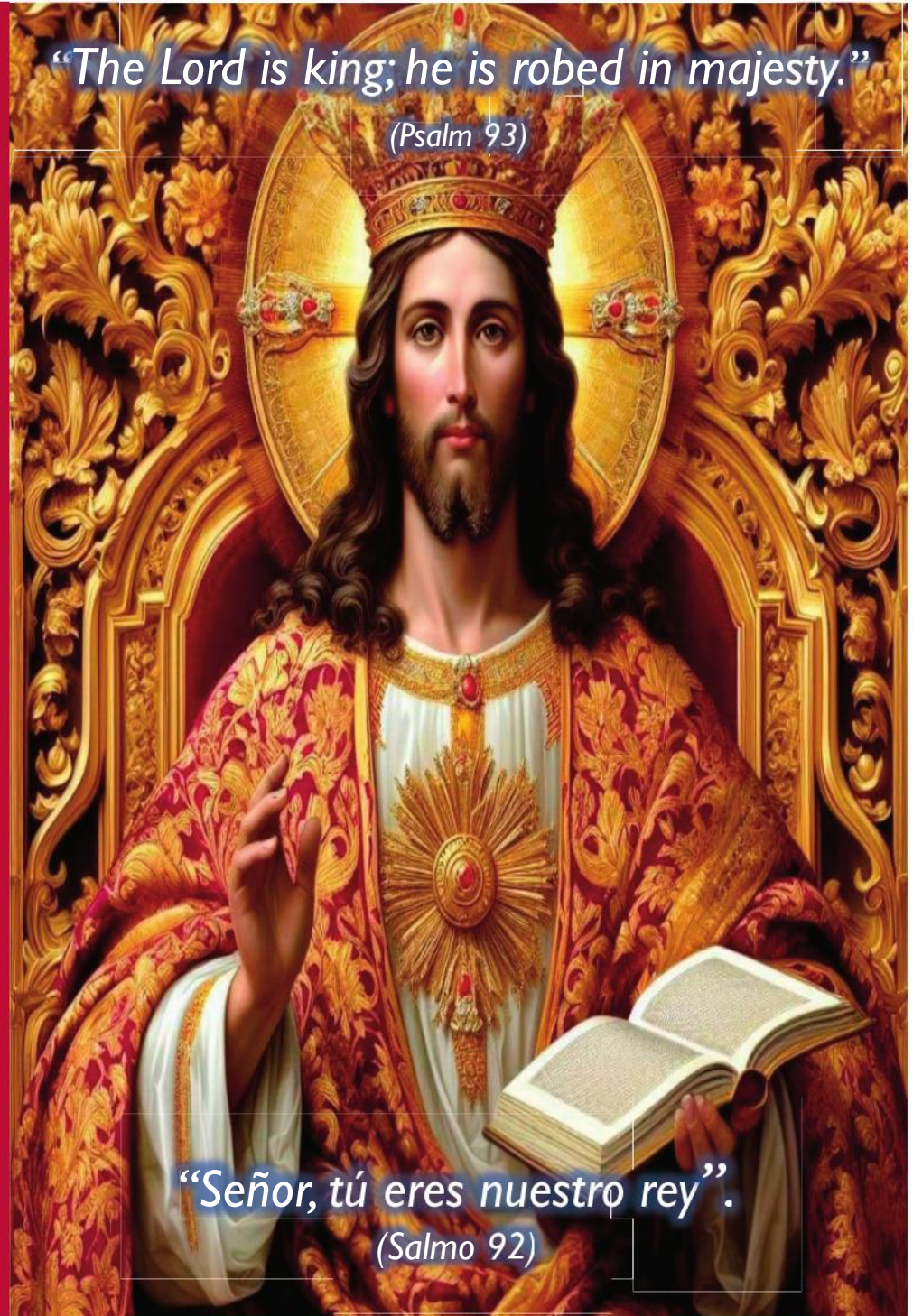

## CHRIST IS KING FOREVER



The celebration of the Solemnity of Christ the King this Sunday is the end of the liturgical calendar. Next Sunday, we will celebrate the First Sunday of Advent, which marks the beginning of a new liturgical year in our Catholic Church.

Nowadays, we are more familiar with democracies than with kingdoms. Current kings and queens are a part of history, and in countries with them, they are decorative or romantic symbols of traditional families. They lack the authority to govern, lead a nation, or create laws. In fact, we may even consider presidents to be more powerful than kings.

When we talk about Christ's Kingship, we should think of him as a King whose Reign is eternal and Universal, and his highest law is love. As we proclaim in the Creed, His Kingdom has no end. Many kings and queens of the past had power in this world, and once they died, all recognition and honor vanished. Many of them will not be present in the minds of future generations. After over 2,000 years, the situation with Christ is completely different; He continues reigning in the world. The world is full of joy celebrating his birth.

Furthermore, our life in Christ is not reserved for some future date but is experienced here and now, though it will be brought to completion and perfection in the life to come. The Lord himself has told us, "Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). This kind of promise comes from our King and Messiah, who has a mission to give us life in abundance, to save us, and to give us peace and salvation.

It is Christ the King who strengthens the tired and lifts up those who are falling down or broken. Christ consoles the afflicted, cures the sick, and gives food to the hungry. We must view this assistance as extending beyond the material and physical realms to a deeper reality rooted in the spiritual and eternal Kingdom that will never end.

Lord Jesus reigns in our lives!

Like the talents in the parable that were placed in the hands of the servants, we want to be good stewards who diligently multiply the gifts we have received to leave a legacy to new generations.

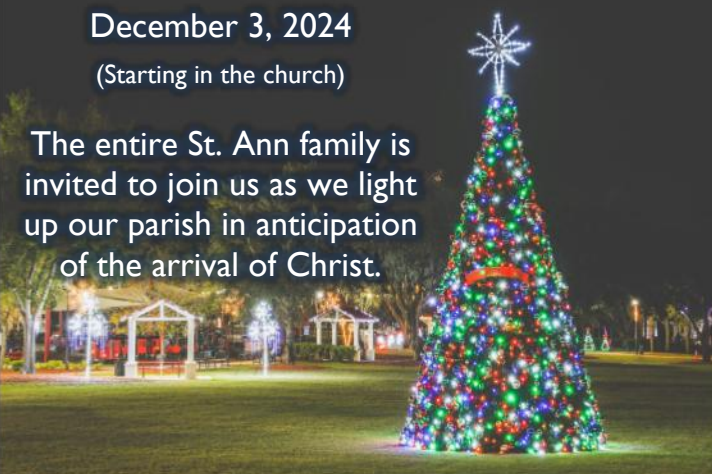

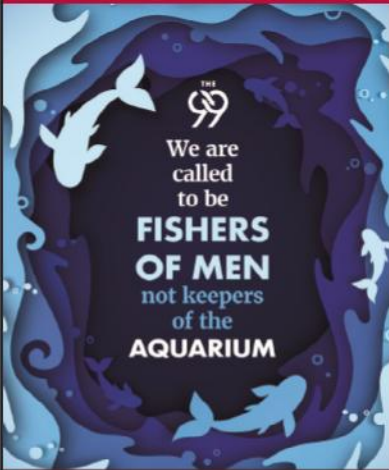

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ANDREW THE APOSTLE



Andrew was St. Peter's brother and was called with him. "As [Jesus] was walking by the sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon, who is now called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, 'Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.' At once they left their nets and followed him" (Matthew 4:18-20).

John the Evangelist presents Andrew as a disciple of John the Baptist. When Jesus walked by one day, John said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." Andrew and another disciple followed Jesus. "Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come, and you will see.' So they went and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day" (John 1:38-39a).

Little else is said about Andrew in the Gospels. Before the multiplication of the loaves, it was Andrew who spoke up about the boy who had the barley loaves and fishes. When the Gentiles went to see Jesus, they came to Philip, but Philip then had recourse to Andrew.

Legend has it that Andrew preached the Good News in what is now modern Greece and Turkey and was crucified at Patras on an X-shaped cross.

**Reflection:** As in the case of all the apostles except Peter and John, the Gospels give us little about the holiness of Andrew. He was an apostle. That is enough. Jesus called him personally to proclaim the Good News, heal with Jesus' power, and share his life and death. Holiness today is no different. It is a gift that includes a call to be concerned about the Kingdom and an outgoing attitude that wants nothing more than to share the riches of Christ with all people.



La celebración de la Solemnidad de Cristo Rey este domingo marca el fin del calendario litúrgico. El próximo domingo celebraremos el Primer Domingo de Adviento, que marca el inicio de un nuevo año litúrgico en nuestra Iglesia Católica.

Hoy en día, estamos más familiarizados con las democracias que con los reinos. Los reyes y reinas actuales son parte de la historia, y en los países que las tienen, son símbolos decorativos o románticos de las familias tradicionales. Carecen de autoridad para gobernar, dirigir una nación o crear leyes. De hecho, incluso podemos considerar a los presidentes como más poderosos que los reyes.

Cuando hablamos de la realeza de Cristo, debemos pensar en él como un Rey cuyo Reinado es eterno y universal, y su ley suprema es el amor. Como proclamamos en el Credo, su Reino no tiene fin. Muchos reyes y reinas del pasado tuvieron poder en este mundo, y una vez que murieron, todo reconocimiento y honor se desvanecieron. Muchos de ellos no estarán presentes en la mente de las generaciones futuras. Después de más de 2.000 años, la situación con Cristo es completamente diferente; Él sigue reinando en el mundo. El mundo está lleno de alegría celebrando su nacimiento.

Además, nuestra vida en Cristo no está reservada para una fecha futura, sino que se vive aquí y ahora, aunque se completará y perfeccionará en la vida venidera. El Señor mismo nos ha dicho: “Venid a mí todos los que estáis cansados y agobiados, y yo os haré descansar” (Mateo 11:28). Este tipo de promesa viene de nuestro Rey y Mesías, que tiene la misión de darnos vida en abundancia, salvarnos, darnos paz y salvación.

Es Cristo el Rey quien fortalece a los cansados y levanta a los que están caídos o quebrantados. Cristo consuela a los afligidos, cura a los enfermos y da de comer a los hambrientos. Debemos ver esta ayuda como algo que se extiende más allá de los reinos materiales y físicos hacia una realidad más profunda arraigada en el Reino espiritual y eterno que nunca tendrá fin.

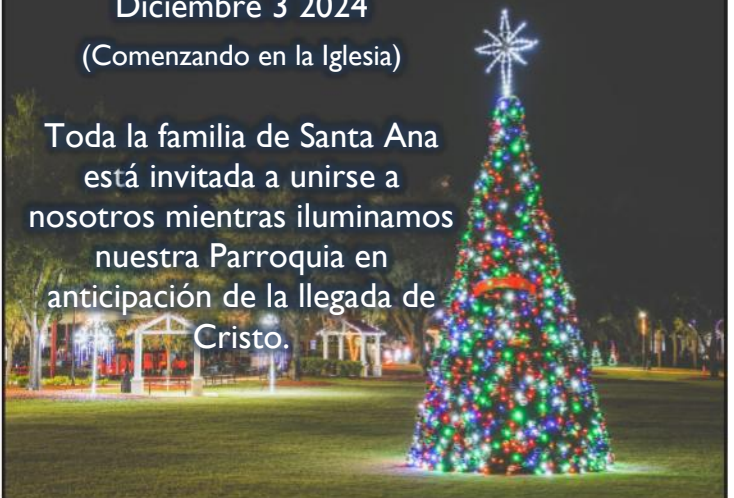
