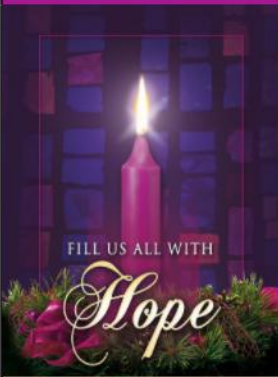

HAPPY WAITING



The coming of the Lord is imminent, and sometimes, we become afraid when thinking about how it will be. But the reality is that we have to talk about not only one coming of the Lord but three comings of the Lord, and each one is significant for us to understand in its own way.

Advent comes from the Latin word *advenio*, which means “the coming”—not “he came” but “the coming.” The phrase “the coming” instead of “he came” conveys a sense of continuity rather than just a one-time occurrence. You can understand what this means by looking at the Old Testament and the readings.

Of course, the First Coming is when the child, the Savior, Emmanuel, God with us arrives. He comes to Bethlehem, which is historically a place in the 1st Century. In the First Coming, God comes in the silence of the middle of the night. God is present in the tenderness of a baby, which we celebrate at Christmas.

The Second Coming is more dramatic. Furthermore, St. Luke explains very well all the visible signs in the sun, moon, and stars. Moreover, he continues by saying, “The powers of heaven will be shaken.” But when will it happen? According to Jesus, our Savior, the answer is unknown. “Only the Father knows.” His answer comes with much hope: “I will come in a cloud with the angels. And I will come and begin the new world.” When love triumphs over hate, people begin to understand, care for, and love each other. This is the world that God intended, and this is the world that will be initiated when Jesus comes the second time.

The Third Coming is that Jesus is with us. The Risen Lord will be with us now on the journey through the years, no matter how long it takes, and will stay at our side and never abandon us. His presence in the Eucharist gives us the certainty that He is the bread of life, which we need for this present time and spiritual nourishment for the journey to Heaven.

Advent is the season of hope because the promise is that no matter what happens, one truth will remain: “I will be with you all days, even to the end of the world.”

1. **THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS** on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (December 8) has been transferred to **Monday, December 9**. Since December 8 is on a Sunday, the Second Sunday of Advent is observed, taking precedence over the Solemnity.
2. Due to the celebration of the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, there are no classes on Thursday, December 12, 2024.
3. **On Saturday, December 14, each class session will perform a short presentation of the moment the angels announced the Good News to the shepherds that a Savior had been born.**

The children’s performance will take place in front of the Fr. Carlos Building. Stay and watch the children perform! Each presentation will begin 30 minutes after each session begins. Classes start at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 12:00 PM. Everyone is welcome!

6. Classes will break for the Christmas holiday on Monday, December 23, 2024, and will resume as follows:
 - **The ONCE-A-MONTH** Faith Formation Classes will resume on Sunday, January 5, 2025.
 - **Thursday classes** will resume on Thursday, January 9, 2025.
 - **Saturday classes** will resume on Saturday, January 11, 2025.
 - **Tuesday classes** will resume on Tuesday, January 14, 2025.

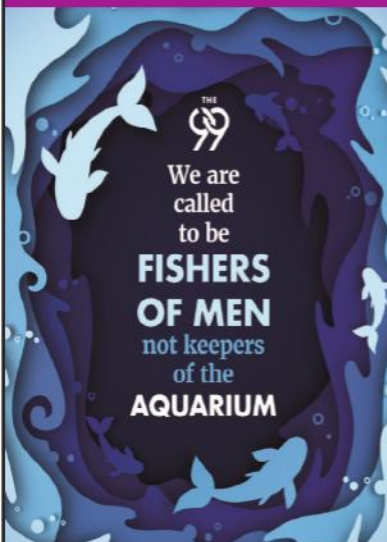

SAINT OF THE WEEK: IMMACULATE CONCEPTION



The Conception of Mary feast arose in the Eastern Church in the seventh century. It came to the West in the eighth century. In the 11th century, it received its present name, the Immaculate Conception. In the 18th century, it became a feast for the universal Church. It is now recognized as a solemnity.

In 1854, Pius IX solemnly proclaimed: “The most Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, because of the merits of Jesus Christ, the savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin.”

It took a long time for this doctrine to develop. While many Fathers and Doctors of the Church considered Mary the greatest and holiest of the saints, they often had difficulty in seeing Mary as sinless—either at her conception or throughout her life. This is one of the Church teachings that arose more from the piety of the faithful than from the insights of brilliant theologians. Even such champions of Mary as Bernard of Clairvaux and Thomas Aquinas could not see theological justification for this teaching.

Two Franciscans, William of Ware and Blessed John Duns Scotus, helped develop the theology. They pointed out that Mary’s Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus’ redemptive work. Other members of the human race are cleansed from original sin after birth. In Mary, Jesus’ work was so powerful as to prevent original sin at the outset.

Reflection: In Luke 1:28, the angel Gabriel, speaking on God’s behalf, addresses Mary as “full of grace” or “highly favored.” In that context, this phrase means that Mary receives all the special divine help necessary for the task ahead. However, the Church grows in understanding with the help of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit led the Church, especially non-theologians, to the insight that Mary had to be the most perfect work of God next to the Incarnation. Or rather, Mary’s intimate association with the Incarnation called for the special involvement of God in Mary’s whole life.

The logic of piety helped God’s people to believe that Mary was full of grace and free of sin from the first moment of her existence. Moreover, this great privilege of Mary is the highlight of all that God has done in Jesus. Rightly understood, the incomparable holiness of Mary shows forth the incomparable goodness of God.

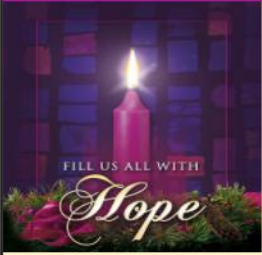

La venida del Señor es inminente y, a veces, nos da miedo pensar en cómo será. Pero la realidad es que no sólo tenemos que hablar de una venida del Señor, sino de tres venidas del Señor, y cada una es significativa para que la entendamos a su manera.

Adviento viene de la palabra latina advenio, que significa “la venida”; no “él vino”. sino “la venida”. La frase “la venida” en lugar de “él vino” transmite una sensación de continuidad en lugar de un solo acontecimiento. Puedes entender lo que esto significa mirando el Antiguo Testamento y las lecturas.

Por supuesto, la Primera Venida es cuando llega el niño, el Salvador, Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros. Viene a Belén, que históricamente es un lugar del siglo I. En la Primera Venida, Dios viene en el silencio de la mitad de la noche. Dios está presente en la ternura de un bebé, que celebramos en Navidad.

La Segunda Venida es más dramática. Además, San Lucas explica muy bien todos los signos visibles en el sol, la luna y las estrellas. Además, continúa diciendo: “Las potencias del cielo serán sacudidas”. Pero ¿cuándo sucederá? Según Jesús, nuestro Salvador, la respuesta es desconocida. “Sólo el Padre lo sabe”. Su respuesta viene con mucha esperanza: “Vendré en una nube con los ángeles. Y vendré y comenzaré el nuevo mundo”. Cuando el amor triunfa sobre el odio, las personas comienzan a comprenderse, cuidarse y amarse mutuamente. Este es el mundo que Dios quiso, y este es el mundo que se iniciará cuando Jesús venga por segunda vez.

La Tercera Venida es que Jesús está con nosotros. El Señor Resucitado estará con nosotros ahora en el viaje a través de los años, no importa cuánto tiempo tome, y permanecerá a nuestro lado y nunca nos abandonará. Su presencia en la Eucaristía nos da la certeza de que Él es el pan de vida, que necesitamos para este tiempo presente y el alimento espiritual para el viaje al Cielo.

El Adviento es tiempo de esperanza porque la promesa es que, pase lo que pase, una verdad permanecerá: “Yo estaré con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo”.

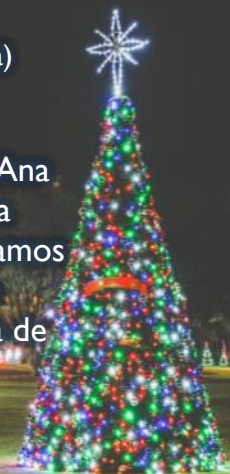
