## METANOIA



We have already reached the Second Sunday of Advent, just two-and-a-half weeks away from Christmas. Today's Gospel is filled with the great voice of John the Baptist during Advent. The Baptist is a story we've heard many times, including how he was Jesus' cousin and knew Jesus as a child. In the Visitation, Mother Mary visited Elizabeth while Elizabeth was pregnant with the child who would become the precursor of the Messiah.

So now, we have gone from the Christmas period to much later. John the Baptist grew up and, relatively early in his life, decided to go to the desert to live an ascetic lifestyle. The desert is a special place to prepare and form prophets, holy men of God. Only those with solid spirits can survive in this vast wilderness area. The desert is the ideal place to pray and meet God, hearing his voice with a great message of hope because there is no distraction.

The Jewish people had been praying for over two thousand years, hoping that God would send the one promised by Moses, the one spoken about by all the prophets, the Holy One of God, the Blessed One of God, the one who was to make Israel free and create a whole new world.

John the Baptist walked out like Elijah the prophet had done many years earlier, wearing camel hair and eating locusts and honey. He came with a solid and straightforward message: "Get ready for the coming of the Lord. Make open your hearts to receive him." In short, the message is: "Hear my voice. It is time to turn your lives around."

He came preaching the Gospel of repentance. The word is "metanoia," which means more than just repentance, turning around on your knees, and being sorry for your sins. Your life will change due to the imminent appearance of the Messiah.

Today, this Advent message from John the Baptist resonates in our minds. We are being invited to be ready and prepare our hearts for the Second Coming of the Lord. We don't know when it will happen, but our work is to prepare and wait for the Lord with joy because our salvation is coming.

## OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

1. **THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS** on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (December 8) has been transferred to **Monday, December 9**. Since December 8 is on a Sunday, the Second Sunday of Advent is observed, taking precedence over the Solemnity.
2. Due to the celebration of the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, there are no classes on Thursday, December 12, 2024.
3. **On Saturday, December 14, each class session will perform a short presentation of the moment the angels announced the Good News to the shepherds that a Savior had been born.**

The children's performance will take place in front of the Fr. Carlos Building. Stay and watch the children perform! Each presentation will begin 30 minutes after each session begins. Classes start at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 12:00 PM. Everyone is welcome!

6. Classes will break for the Christmas holiday on Monday, December 23, 2024, and will resume as follows:

- **The ONCE-A-MONTH** Faith Formation Classes will resume on Sunday, January 5, 2025. **(This is a change!)**
- **Thursday classes** will resume on Thursday, January 9, 2025.
- **Saturday classes** will resume on Saturday, January 11, 2025.
- **Tuesday classes** will resume on Tuesday, January 14, 2025.

## OUR LEGACY CONTINUES

We want to remind all those who wish to participate in the remodeling of the Fr. Anderson Building with the "Make Our Legacy New" campaign of the following important instructions:

1. If you received a pledge envelope, it is important to remember that the immediate objective is to collect personal information such as: Name, Address, and Phone Number.
2. With this information given, you will be counted as one of the donors the campaign requires for the next three years. It is vitally important that this information is on the envelope.

## JESSE TREE

The Jesse tree helps us connect the custom of decorating Christmas trees to the events leading to Jesus' birth. The Jesse tree is named from Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot shall come out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." Jesse was the father of King David. We adorn a Jesse tree with illustrated ornaments that represent the people, prophecies, and events leading up to the birth of Jesus. The ornaments of the Jesse tree tell the story of God in the Old Testament, connecting the Advent season with the faithfulness of God across four thousand years of history.

Join us as we follow the journey to Bethlehem while we place the ornaments in our Jesse tree every day after the 9:00 AM Mass.

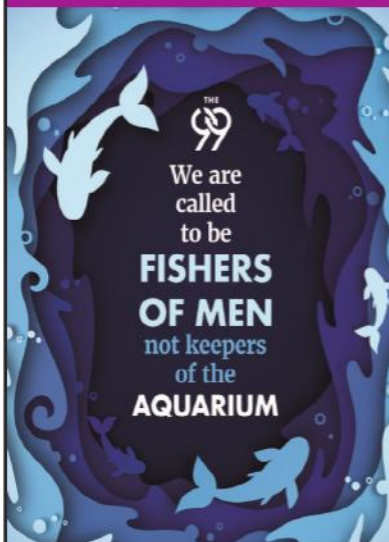

## CHRISTMAS IN BETHLEHEM

In 2021, we as a parish collected \$3,600, which was sent to Bethlehem to purchase presents for 220 children there who would otherwise not receive any gifts for Christmas.

Due to the difficulties in the Middle East, including war and social difficulties, there is no tourism and, therefore, no way for people to sustain their daily needs. Tourism is their main source of income in the land where Jesus was born. That means this year, children in Bethlehem will have no presents.

Since we already have multiple commitments this holiday season, we have thought of helping Bethlehem during this economic crisis in which they found themselves living by sending funds that we, as a parish, can collect.

During the Aguinaldo Masses (5:00 AM) and Novena Masses (9:00 AM), we will be holding a special collection. All the money collected will be sent to ensure these unfortunate children have a Merry Christmas.

## METANOIA



Ya hemos llegado al segundo domingo de Adviento, a sólo dos semanas y media de Navidad. El Evangelio de hoy está lleno de la gran voz de Juan el Bautista durante el Adviento. El Bautista es una historia que hemos escuchado muchas veces, incluyendo cómo era primo de Jesús y conoció a Jesús cuando era niño. En la Visitación, la Madre María visitó a Isabel mientras Isabel estaba embarazada del niño que se convertiría en el precursor del Mesías.

Así que ahora, hemos pasado del período de Navidad a mucho más tarde. Juan el Bautista creció y, relativamente temprano en su vida, decidió ir al desierto para vivir un estilo de vida ascético. El desierto es un lugar especial para preparar y formar profetas, hombres santos de Dios. Solo aquellos con espíritus sólidos pueden sobrevivir en esta vasta área desértica. El desierto es el lugar ideal para orar y encontrarse con Dios, escuchando su voz con un gran mensaje de esperanza porque no hay distracciones.

El pueblo judío había estado orando durante más de dos mil años, esperando que Dios enviara al prometido por Moisés, del que hablaron todos los profetas, el Santo de Dios, el Bendito de Dios, el que liberaría a Israel y crearía un mundo completamente nuevo.

Juan el Bautista salió como lo había hecho el profeta Elías muchos años antes, vestido de pelo de camello y comiendo langostas y miel. Vino con un mensaje sólido y directo: "Prepárense para la venida del Señor. Abran sus corazones para recibirlo". En resumen, el mensaje es: "Escuchen mi voz. Es hora de cambiar sus vidas".

Vino predicando el Evangelio del arrepentimiento. La palabra es "metanoia", que significa más que solo arrepentirse, ponerse de rodillas y arrepentirse de sus pecados. Su vida cambiará debido a la inminente aparición del Mesías.

Hoy, este mensaje de Adviento de Juan el Bautista resuena en nuestras mentes. Se nos invita a estar listos y preparar nuestros corazones para la Segunda Venida del Señor. No sabemos cuándo sucederá, pero nuestro trabajo es prepararnos y esperar al Señor con alegría porque nuestra salvación está llegando.

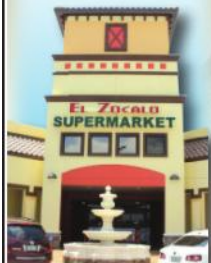
