



FISHING MASTER



In today's Gospel, Jesus, the prophet of Nazareth, the Master who delivered many speeches and had shown signs and great prodigies, now became a fishing teacher who knows more about fishing than those who, for many years since they were children, had dedicated their lives to fish in the Sea of Galilee. Jesus was preaching from Simon's boat. Many people longed to listen to Him, but the Lord Jesus stopped his primary mission, turned to Simon, and instructed him on where to lower the fishing nets. Simon and others had been fishing throughout the night and had not caught anything. Simon protests because he considers himself a real expert, claiming such an effort would be useless. Simon ultimately obeys Jesus as an act of courtesy and lowers his nets into the deeper water as directed. Notice here that Peter calls Jesus by the title "master." He already recognizes Jesus as a person of authority only in things like healing, liberation from evil spirits, and sound and exceptional messages. But his obedience was more for respect than for other reasons. The result of his obedience is that they catch so many fish that the nets begin to tear; Jesus' presence has created abundance out of shortage, just as it did at the wedding feast at Cana, and this sign makes his disciples believe in Him.

Simon Peter immediately becomes a follower of Jesus. He calls Jesus "Lord"—the title given to Jesus after his Resurrection—and protests his worthiness to be in Jesus' presence. Today's Gospel, therefore, marks a turning point in the relationship between Jesus and Peter.

Two of Simon's partners are also named as witnesses to the event described in today's Gospel: Zebedee's sons, James and John. Yet Jesus' words are addressed only to Simon. Jesus gives Simon a new job, telling him he will become a different kind of fisherman. No longer will he catch fish; instead, he will seek people. In these words, we hear the beginning of the leadership role that Peter will have within the community of disciples. Peter was chosen for this role of great responsibility and influence. His task will be to bring others to Jesus. Already, he is doing so; the Gospel tells us that all the fishermen with Peter also left their nets and followed Jesus.

Through his signs and word, the Son of God made people, and in this case, the first disciples, leave everything and follow Him.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: APOLLONIA



The persecution of Christians began in Alexandria during the reign of the Emperor Philip. The first victim of the pagan mob was an older man named Metrius, who was tortured and then stoned to death. The second person who refused to worship their false idols was a Christian woman named Quinta. Her words infuriated the mob, and she was scourged and stoned.

While most of the Christians were fleeing the city, abandoning all their worldly possessions, an old deaconess, Apollonia, was seized. The crowds beat her, knocking out all of her teeth. Then they lit a large fire and threatened to throw her in it if she did not curse her God. She begged them to wait a moment, acting like she was considering their requests. Instead, she jumped willingly into the flames and so suffered martyrdom.

There were many churches and altars dedicated to her. Apollonia is the patroness of dentists, and people suffering from a toothache and other dental diseases often ask for her intercession. She is pictured with a pair of pincers holding a tooth or a golden tooth suspended from her necklace. St. Augustine explained her voluntary martyrdom as a special inspiration of the Holy Spirit since no one is allowed to cause their own death.

Reflection: The Church has quite a sense of humor! Apollonia is honored as the patron saint of dentists, but this woman who had her teeth extracted without anesthetic surely ought to be the patron of those who dread the chair. She might also be the patron of the aging, for she attained glory in her old age, standing firm before her persecutors even as her fellow Christians fled the city. However we choose to honor her, she remains a model of courage for us.

MAESTRO DE PESCA



En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús, el profeta de Nazaret, el Maestro que había pronunciado muchos discursos y mostrado señales y grandes prodigios, ahora se convirtió en un maestro de pesca que sabe más de pesca que aquellos que, desde niños, habían dedicado su vida a pescar en el Mar de Galilea. Jesús predicaba desde la barca de Simón. Mucha gente anhelaba escucharlo, pero el Señor Jesús detuvo su misión principal, se dirigió a Simón y le indicó dónde bajar las redes de pesca. Simón y otros habían estado pescando durante toda la noche y no habían pescado nada. Simón protesta porque se considera un verdadero experto, alegando que tal esfuerzo sería inútil. Simón finalmente obedece a Jesús como un acto de cortesía y baja sus redes a aguas más profundas como le indicó. Observe aquí que Pedro llama a Jesús por el título de "maestro". Ya reconoce a Jesús como una persona de autoridad solo en cosas como la curación, la liberación de espíritus malignos y los mensajes sonoros y excepcionales.

Pero su obediencia fue más por respeto que por otras razones. El resultado de su obediencia es que pescan tantos peces que las redes comienzan a romperse; la presencia de Jesús ha creado abundancia de la escasez, tal como sucedió en la fiesta de bodas de Caná, y esta señal hace que sus discípulos crean en Él.

Simón Pedro se convierte inmediatamente en un seguidor de Jesús. Llama a Jesús "Señor"—el título dado a Jesús después de su Resurrección—y protesta por su dignidad para estar en la presencia de Jesús. El Evangelio de hoy, por lo tanto, marca un punto de inflexión en la relación entre Jesús y Pedro.

Dos de los socios de Simón también son nombrados como testigos del evento descrito en el Evangelio de hoy: los hijos de Zebedeo, Santiago y Juan. Sin embargo, las palabras de Jesús se dirigen solo a Simón. Jesús le da a Simón un nuevo trabajo, diciéndole que se convertirá en un tipo diferente de pescador. Ya no pescará peces, sino que buscará personas. En estas palabras, escuchamos el comienzo del papel de liderazgo que Pedro tendrá dentro de la comunidad de discípulos. Pedro fue elegido para este papel de gran responsabilidad e influencia. Su tarea será llevar a otros a Jesús. Ya lo está haciendo; el Evangelio nos dice que todos los pescadores, junto con Pedro, también dejaron las redes y siguieron a Jesús.

A través de sus signos y su palabra, el Hijo de Dios hizo que las personas, y en este caso, los primeros discípulos, lo dejaran todo y lo siguieran.
