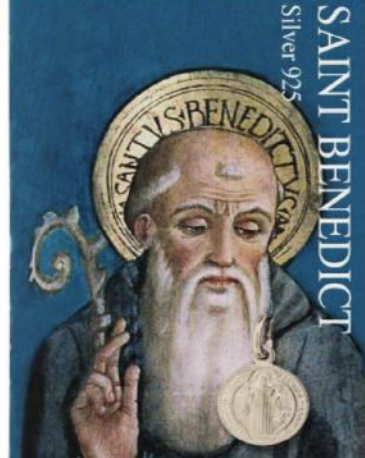

THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND



Today is the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. “Ordinary Time” in this sense does not mean it is just ordinary, as if it lacked importance. That could not be further from the truth. Ordinary Time, in this sense, is based on the Latin word *ordinalis*. It refers to the sequential numbering of the weeks of the year—a time when we focus on the life and ministry of Jesus.

The first reading, from the Book of Isaiah, serves as a gentle reminder of God’s immense love for all His people. His love is so tender it should bring us great comfort, knowing that we are all under His caring gaze.

The second reading is from Galatians. St. Paul reminds us that we should boast only in the Cross of Jesus Christ. It was at this significant cost of enduring the Cross that Jesus won our redemption. Every time we look at a Cross or Crucifix, we should reflect on what our Savior has done for us out of love while we were still yet sinners. Seeing such love and mercy should help us become loving and merciful to all people.

In the Gospel of Luke today, we hear the beautiful words, “The Kingdom of God is at hand.” This helps us to reflect on just how close our God is to us. It should give us a moment to pause and ask ourselves, “Am I living as though I am part of the Kingdom?” Do I put the love of God first in my life? Do I love others the same way that God loves me? We should take stock of where we are and how God is calling us to be. We should strive to live this life of love first for God, then for all. To help us with this, Jesus has left us the gift of the Eucharist so that we may become what we receive and live how God has called us to live.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: VERONICA GIULIANI



Veronica's desire to be like Christ crucified was answered with the stigmata.

Veronica was born in Mercatelli, Italy. It is said that when her mother, Benedetta, was dying, she called her five daughters to her bedside and entrusted each of them to one of the five wounds of Jesus. Veronica was entrusted with the wound below Christ's heart.

At the age of 17, Veronica joined the Poor Clares directed by the Capuchins. Her father had wanted her to marry, but she convinced him to allow her to become a nun. In her first years in the monastery, she worked in the kitchen, infirmary, sacristy, and also served as portress. At the age of 34, she was made novice mistress, a position she held for 22 years. When she was 37, Veronica received the stigmata. Life was not the same after that.

Church authorities in Rome wanted to test Veronica's authenticity and so conducted an investigation. She lost the office of novice mistress temporarily and was not allowed to attend Mass except on Sundays or holy days. Through all of this, Veronica did not become bitter, and the investigation eventually restored her to the position of novice mistress.

Though she protested against it, at the age of 56, she was elected abbess, an office she held for 11 years until her death. Veronica was very devoted to the Eucharist and to the Sacred Heart. She offered her sufferings for the missions, died in 1727, and was canonized in 1839. Her Liturgical Feast Day is July 9.

Reflection: Why did God grant the stigmata to Francis of Assisi and Veronica Giuliani? God alone knows the deepest reasons, but as Celano points out, the external sign of the cross is a confirmation of these saints' commitment to the cross in their lives. The stigmata that appeared in Veronica's flesh had taken root in her heart many years before. It was a fitting conclusion for her love of God and her charity toward her sisters.

THE POPES AND THE POWER AND SIGNIFICANCE OF THE ST. BENEDICT MEDAL



The St. Benedict Medal, recognized by the Catholic Church, is believed to possess a great power of exorcism and liberation from demonic influences. However, it is essential to understand that its efficacy does not lie solely in its physical appearance or the engraved prayer, as this would fall into superstition. Rather, the true power of the Medal resides in Christ Himself, who grants it to the Church through the fervent disposition of those who use it.

The Origins and Miraculous Healing Associated with the Medal:

Originating from ancient times, the effectiveness of the St. Benedict Medal or Cross deserves special attention. Its popularity surged in the second decade of the 11th century when a man named Brunone, residing in Alsace, was miraculously healed from a severe illness after being presented with the aforementioned Medal. Following his recovery, Brunone became a Benedictine monk and was later elected Pope, taking the name Leo IX (later canonized as a saint). In 1742, Pope Benedict XIV approved the Medal and granted indulgences to those who carried it with faith.

Deciphering the Symbolism on the Front and Back of the Medal:

The front of the Medal portrays an image of St. Benedict at its center. In his right hand, he holds a cross, symbolizing the saving power of Christ and the evangelizing work of the Benedictines throughout the centuries. To his right, a broken cup signifies the rebellious monks who attempted to poison St. Benedict but failed when he made the sign of the cross over it. On his left, a raven holds a poisoned loaf of bread, another failed attempt on the saint's life.

Above St. Benedict's head is "*Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti*" (Cross of the Holy Father Benedict). Surrounding the edge are the words: "*Ejus en obitu nostro praesentia muniamus*" (May we be strengthened by his presence in our hour of death.). Beneath his feet, the letters "*EX SM CASINO MDCCCLXX*" (From the holy Monte Cassino, 1880) are inscribed.

The reverse side of the Medal features a large cross as its dominant symbol. Each of the cross's four sides contains the initials: "*C.S.P.B.*" (*Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti*), meaning "*Cross of the Holy Father Benedict.*" In the vertical line of the cross, the initials "*C.S.S.M.L.*" (*Crux Sacra Sit Mihi Lux*) signify "*May the Holy Cross be my light,*" while the initials "*N.D.S.M.D.*" (*Non Draco Sit Mihi Dux*) in the horizontal line express "*May the devil not be my guide.*"

Around the border, starting from the top and progressing clockwise, are the initials of the exorcism prayer:

"*V.R.S.*" (*Vade Retro Satana*): "*Begone, Satan.*" "*N.S.M.V.*" (*Non Suade Mihi Vana*): "*Do not suggest to me vain things*" "*S.M.Q.L.*" (*Sunt Mala Quae Libas*): "*What you offer is evil*" "*I.V.B.*" (*Ipse Venena Bibas*): "*Drink your own poison.*"

The prayer concludes with "*PAX*" (Peace). Thus, the prayer recites as follows: "*May the Holy Cross be my light, and may the devil not be my guide. Begone, Satan. Do not suggest to me vain things. What you offer is evil. Drink your poison. Peace.*"



Hoy es el decimocuarto domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. En este sentido, «Tiempo Ordinario» no significa que sea simplemente ordinario, como si careciera de importancia. Nada más lejos de la realidad. El Tiempo Ordinario, en este sentido, se basa en la palabra latina «ordinalis». Se refiere a la numeración secuencial de las semanas del año, un tiempo en el que nos centramos en la vida y el ministerio de Jesús.

La primera lectura, tomada del libro de Isaías, nos recuerda con dulzura el inmenso amor de Dios por todo su pueblo. Su amor es tan tierno que debería consolarnos, sabiendo que todos estamos bajo su mirada protectora.

La segunda lectura es de Gálatas. San Pablo nos recuerda que debemos gloriarnos solo en la cruz de Jesucristo. Fue a este alto precio de soportar la cruz que Jesús obtuvo nuestra redención. Cada vez que contemplamos una cruz o un crucifijo, debemos reflexionar en lo que nuestro Salvador hizo por nosotros por amor mientras aún éramos pecadores. Ver tal amor y misericordia nos ayudará a ser amorosos y misericordiosos con todas las personas.

El evangelista Lucas nos habla hoy, acerca de estas profundas palabras: «El Reino de Dios está cerca». Esto nos ayuda a reflexionar sobre cuán cerca está nuestro Dios de nosotros. Nos debe dar un momento para detenernos y preguntarnos: «¿Estoy viviendo cómo si fuera parte del Reino?». ¿He puesto el amor de Dios en primer lugar en mi vida? ¿Amo a los demás cómo Dios me ama? Debemos evaluar dónde estamos y cómo Dios nos llama a ser. Debemos esforzarnos por vivir esta vida de amor primero a Dios y luego a todos. Para ayudarnos con esto, Jesús nos dejó el don de la Eucaristía para que seamos lo que recibimos y vivamos como Dios nos ha llamado a vivir.

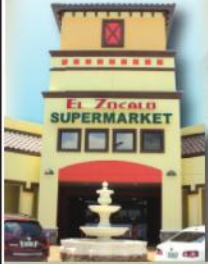
