TWO WAYS, ONE LORD



In the Gospel for this weekend, we find the classic explanation of the two different ways to follow the Lord Jesus and become truly disciples of Him.

The first way is through action. In the Gospel, Martha represents the active disciple; she receives Jesus into her life, her heart is moved with compassion, and seeing the needs of others, she is able to serve and help them with love. The second way is well represented in Mary, with the contemplative discipleship style of life. Which of the two is more desirable? It all depends on what calling we received.

Some are called to active ministry, but Jesus gently reproached Martha for being so anxious and worried about so many things. On the other hand, she approved of Mary's decision to sit down and listen to every word he spoke. Indeed, "man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." Martha's active ministry lacked spiritual input and enlightenment. That is why she was too busy and worried about so many things. Mary's attention to Jesus' words must have given her enough light and inspiration to embark on a more fruitful and educational ministry, free of worries and anxiety.

Jesus made Martha realize that in any activity and service to God, faith is essential, so that there is no need to worry and be anxious. One has, therefore, to take time to be still and listen to the Word of God with full faith and trust in His wisdom and providence.

Let us accept Jesus' invitation to be strong disciples of the Lord, blending a life of contemplation with an active life as a result of our faith and love for others. We need both styles of life contemplation and active life to be good messengers of the good news of Salvation.

REGISTRATION FOR THE 2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR!

Seats are available in the following programs:

1. Kindergarten and Grade 1: Intro to the Catholic Faith

While a student will not receive a sacrament at the conclusion of these classes, they are recommended as the most appropriate starting point for a child's formal formation in the Catholic faith.

2. Grades 2-5: formal preparation that leads to receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion

3. Grades 3-6: Continuing Faith Formation program

If your child has already received the sacrament of Holy Communion, these classes are highly recommended as they form the perfect bridge between receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion and the start of your child's formal preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation.

A NOTE TO PARENTS WITH STUDENTS ENTERING GRADES NOT LISTED

It is not unusual for seats to become available in classes once considered full.

Please do not hesitate to contact the Office of Religious Education to inquire about the availability of a seat, allowing us to accommodate your child's need for sacramental preparation.

Please note: Incense will be used at both Masses.

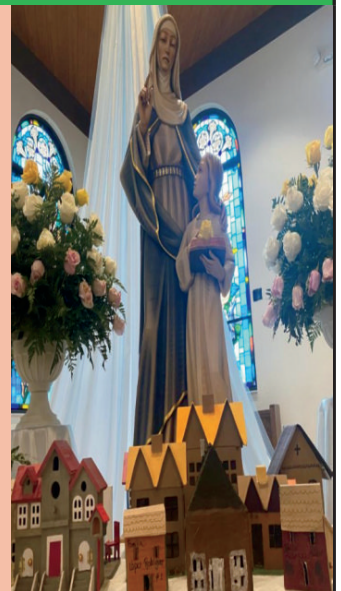

SAINT OF THE WEEK: JOACHIM & ANNE



In the Scriptures, Matthew and Luke furnish a legal family history of Jesus, tracing ancestry to show that Jesus is the culmination of great promises. Not only is his mother's family neglected, but we also know nothing factual about them except that they existed. Even the names "Joachim" and "Anne" originate from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus' death.

The heroism and holiness of these people, however, are inferred from the whole family atmosphere surrounding Mary in the Scriptures. Whether we rely on the legends about Mary's childhood or make guesses from the information in the Bible, we see in her a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons, herself steeped in the religious traditions of her people.

The strong character of Mary in making decisions, her continuous practice of prayer, her devotion to the laws of her faith, her steadiness at moments of crisis, and her devotion to her relatives—all indicate a close-knit, loving family that looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past.

Joachim and Anne—whether these are their real names or not—represent that entire quiet series of generations who faithfully perform their duties, practice their faith, and establish an atmosphere for the coming of the Messiah, but remain obscure.

Reflection: This is the "feast of grandparents." It reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.

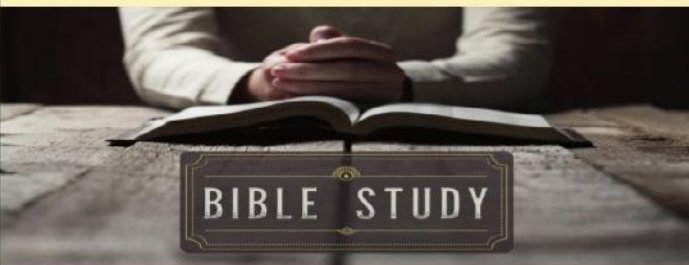

DOS CAMINOS, UN SOLO SEÑOR



En el Evangelio de este fin de semana, encontramos la explicación clásica de las dos maneras de seguir al Señor Jesús y convertirnos en verdaderos discípulos suyos.

La primera es a través de la acción. En el Evangelio, Marta representa al discípulo activo: recibe a Jesús en su vida, su corazón se conmueve de compasión y, al ver las necesidades de los demás, es capaz de servirles y ayudarlos con amor. La segunda forma está bien representada en María, con el estilo de vida del discipulado contemplativo. ¿Cuál de los dos es más deseable? Todo depende del llamado que hayamos recibido.

Algunos son llamados al ministerio activo, pero Jesús le reprochó con ternura a Marta su ansiedad y preocupación por tantas cosas. Por otro lado, ella aprobó la decisión de María de sentarse y escuchar cada palabra que él decía. De hecho, «no solo de pan vive el hombre, sino de toda palabra que sale de la boca de Dios». El ministerio activo de Marta carecía de inspiración espiritual y de iluminación. Por eso estaba demasiado ocupada y preocupada por tantas cosas. La atención de María a las palabras de Jesús debió haberle dado suficiente luz e inspiración para embarcarse en un ministerio más fructífero y educativo, libre de preocupaciones y ansiedades.

Jesús le hizo comprender a Marta que en cualquier actividad y servicio a Dios, la fe es esencial, por lo que no hay necesidad de preocuparse ni angustiarse. Por lo tanto, es necesario tomarse un tiempo para estar en silencio y escuchar la Palabra de Dios con plena fe y confianza en su sabiduría y providencia.

Aceptemos la invitación de Jesús a ser discípulos firmes del Señor, combinando una vida de contemplación con una vida activa, fruto de nuestra fe y amor al prójimo. Necesitamos ambos estilos de vida, contemplativo y activo, para ser buenos mensajeros de la buena nueva de la salvación.
