TALKING TO GOD



Jesus tells us to ask, we will receive, seek, and we will find. Probably not many of us would have to think much to come up with something we have asked for and haven't received. Why didn't we get what we asked for?

We might also think of *how* we ask God for something. Here we think of Abraham. God is preparing to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah for the sins of the people who live there. Abraham speaks to God seeking mercy for the innocent. In this remarkable passage, we witness Abraham engaged in a bold negotiation with God over the fate of Sodom. Abraham's intercession demonstrates both his deep reverence for God and his compassionate concern for others. Beginning with the question, "Will you sweep away the innocent with the guilty?" Abraham gradually reduces the number of righteous people needed to spare the city from fifty to ten.

This reading illustrates several key aspects of intercessory prayer: persistence, humility ("I am but dust and ashes"), and confidence in God's mercy. Abraham approaches God not as a distant deity but as one with whom he can reason and plead. This sets the foundation for understanding the relationship between human petition and divine response that Jesus addresses in the Gospel.

Luke's account of Jesus teaching the Lord's Prayer provides the centerpiece of this Sunday's liturgy. When the disciples ask Jesus to teach them to pray, he offers both a model prayer and teachings about God's generous response to our petitions. Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer is more concise than Matthew's, but it contains the essential elements: reverence for God's name, petition for the kingdom, request for daily needs, forgiveness, and protection from trials.

While a student will not receive a sacrament at the conclusion of these classes, they are recommended as the most appropriate starting point for a child's formal formation in the Catholic faith.

2. Grades 2-5: formal preparation that leads to receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion

3. Grades 3-6: Continuing Faith Formation program

If your child has already received the sacrament of Holy Communion, these classes are highly recommended as they form the perfect bridge between receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion and the start of your child's formal preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation.

It is not unusual for seats to become available in classes once considered full.

REMEMBERING DEACON RICHARD DEMERS WITH GRATITUDE

In Loving Memory of Deacon Richard Demers Ordained May 13, 1989 – Entered Eternal Rest July 21, 2025

With profound sadness and deep faith in the promise of eternal life, we announce the passing of **Deacon Richard Demers**, who was called home to the Lord on **Monday, July 21, 2025**.

Born of Native American roots, Deacon Richard lived a life of deep service to God, country, and family. He was a devoted husband to Jeannine Rivard, his beloved wife of over 44 years. Together, they raised three children—two sons and one daughter—and were blessed with four grandchildren.

Originally from Rhode Island, Deacon Richard and Jeannine relocated from Virginia to Florida in 2010, where he ministered joyfully at Holy Cross Catholic Church and St. Ann Catholic Church in Haines City.

A veteran of the United States Air Force, he served with honor in Arkansas, Nebraska, Southeast Asia, and even at the White House. After completing his military service, he earned a Bachelor's degree in Data Communications from George Mason University and a Master's degree in Religious Studies (with a focus on Spirituality) from Christendom College.

Ordained to the Permanent Diaconate on May 13, 1989, in the Diocese of Arlington by Bishop Richard Keating, he later received faculties to serve in the Diocese of Orlando on May 13, 2015, from Bishop John Noonan.

Deacon Richard dedicated over 50 years to engineering and management before retiring in 2020. Even in retirement, his zeal for ministry never waned. His presence among the sick, in parish life, and his faithful witness were a true gift to the Church.

"May 2021 will mark 32 years in Holy Orders for me, yet it seems like ordination was only yesterday. I want to serve my Lord and His Church in whatever way I can. I also praise Him for giving me two families: my wife, children, and grandchildren, and my family in the Catholic Church." — Deacon Richard Demers

Let us lift him up in prayer and offer thanks for the grace of his life. Funeral details will be announced as soon as they are available.

HABLANDO CON DIOS



Jesús nos dice que pidamos y recibiremos; busquemos y encontraremos. Probablemente no muchos de nosotros tendríamos que pensar mucho para encontrar algo que hemos pedido y no hemos recibido. ¿Por qué no obtuvimos lo que pedimos?

También podríamos pensar en cómo le pedimos algo a Dios. Pensamos en Abraham. Dios se prepara para destruir Sodoma y Gomorra por los pecados de sus habitantes. Abraham le habla a Dios pidiendo misericordia para los inocentes. En este notable pasaje, vemos a Abraham participando en una audaz negociación con Dios sobre el destino de Sodoma. La intercesión de Abraham demuestra tanto su profunda reverencia por Dios como su compasión por los demás. Comenzando con la pregunta: "¿Barrerás al inocente junto con el culpable?", Abraham reduce gradualmente el número de justos necesarios para salvar la ciudad de cincuenta a diez.

Esta lectura ilustra varios aspectos clave de la oración de intercesión: persistencia, humildad ("Solo soy polvo y ceniza") y confianza en la misericordia de Dios. Abraham se acerca a Dios no como una deidad distante, sino como alguien con quien puede razonar y suplicar. Esto sienta las bases para comprender la relación entre la petición humana y la respuesta divina que Jesús aborda en el Evangelio.

El relato de Lucas sobre Jesús enseñando el Padrenuestro constituye el eje central de la liturgia de este domingo. Cuando los discípulos le piden a Jesús que les enseñe a orar, él ofrece tanto un modelo de oración como enseñanzas sobre la generosa respuesta de Dios a nuestras peticiones. La versión de Lucas del Padrenuestro es más concisa que la de Mateo, pero contiene los elementos esenciales: reverencia al nombre de Dios, petición por el reino, solicitud de las necesidades diarias, perdón y protección ante las pruebas.

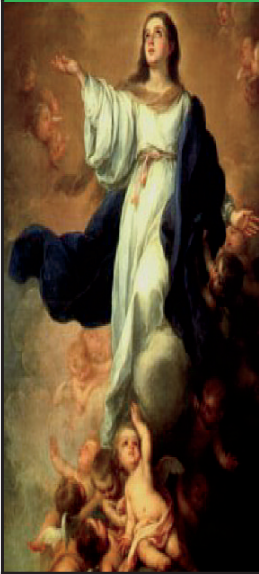

RECORDANDO CON GRATITUD AL DIÁCONO RICHARD DEMERS

En Memoria del Diácono Richard Demers

Ordenado el 13 de mayo de 1989 – Entró en la Vida Eterna el 21 de julio de 2025

Con profunda tristeza, pero con fe en la promesa de la vida eterna, anunciamos el fallecimiento del **Diácono Richard Demers**, quien fue llamado a la Casa del Padre el **lunes 21 de julio de 2025**.

Nacido de raíces nativoamericanas, el Diácono Richard vivió una vida de entrega total a Dios, a su país y a su familia. Fue un esposo fiel y amoroso de Jeannine Rivard, con quien compartió más de 44 años de matrimonio. Juntos formaron una hermosa familia con tres hijos (dos varones y una hija) y cuatro nietos (dos niñas y dos niños).

Originarios de Rhode Island, él y Jeannine se mudaron de Virginia a Florida en febrero de 2010. Aquí en la Diócesis de Orlando, sirvió con amor y entrega en las parroquias de Holy Cross y Santa Ana en Haines City.

Sirvió durante siete años en la Fuerza Aérea de los Estados Unidos, desempeñándose en Arkansas, Nebraska, el sudeste de Asia e incluso en la Casa Blanca. Tras su servicio militar, obtuvo una licenciatura en Comunicaciones de Datos en la Universidad George Mason y una maestría en Estudios Religiosos con énfasis en Espiritualidad de Christendom College.

Fue ordenado diácono permanente el 13 de mayo de 1989 por el obispo Richard Keating en la Diócesis de Arlington (Virginia), y recibió facultades para ejercer el ministerio en la Diócesis de Orlando el 13 de mayo de 2015, otorgadas por el obispo John Noonan.

Su carrera profesional como ingeniero de sistemas se extendió por más de 50 años, tanto en el ámbito privado como en el gobierno. Se retiró en enero de 2020, pero nunca se retiró de su vocación: siguió sirviendo con amor a la Iglesia, a los enfermos y a toda la comunidad parroquial.

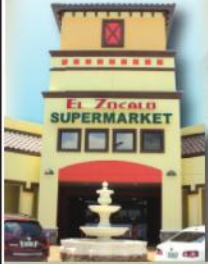
