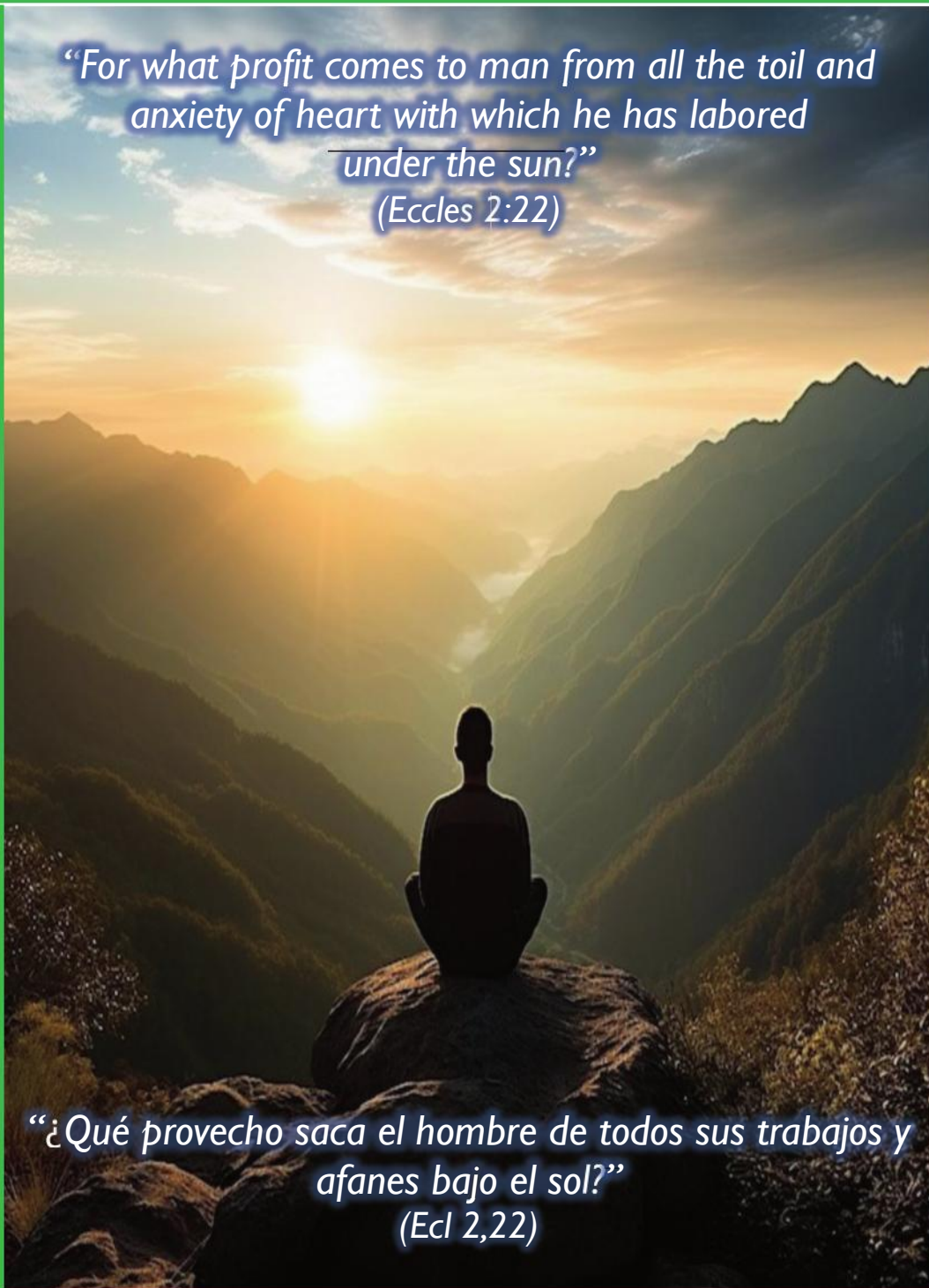

OUR PRIORITY IS HEAVEN



A person comes to Jesus asking for something that was not common at all: “to tell his brother to share the inheritance with me.” It was not a request for a miracle or an essential question about the Kingdom of Heaven; Jesus seems to have ignored the question. Jesus provided a profound reflection through the parable of a man who was preoccupied with material things. Instead, Jesus tells the crowd to “take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one’s life does not consist of possessions.”

What makes people *rich*? What makes you *happy*? What brings you fulfillment in life?

Are material things important? They can be. We need a place to live. We need food to eat, clothing to wear, and a car. But are these things the only things that matter and are extraordinarily important in our lives? Do they determine what our life is worth?

They can occupy our time. We need to be thoughtful about our purchases to get good, dependable items at a fair price, but having these things should never be driven by greed or pride. If we purchase for greed, we acquire more than we need. Or we do so just to be able to boast about what we have, which would not be the intention of the blessings that we have received.

For the man in Jesus’ parable, the store of grain became a sign of success. It is not bad, but rather a symbol of progress and success in God, which serves an essential purpose: to provide what he needs and to share his blessings with others. He was worried only about the present time, with a too-short vision, but the question is, where was his projection for eternal life? Did the store of grain do anything to nourish the man’s soul? Did it do anything for his salvation?

The man died that night. The store of grain did him no good. It was inherited by someone else. The man spent his life focused on earthly things rather than what is above. God was not part of his decision of what to do with the bountiful harvest.

Let us thank God for all the blessings we have received, asking Him to give us a generous heart that enables us to recognize that what we have received from heaven is for sharing with others and for His glory.

While a student will not receive a sacrament at the conclusion of these classes, they are recommended as the most appropriate starting point for a child’s formal formation in the Catholic faith.

2. **Grades 2-5: formal preparation that leads to receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion**

3. **Grades 3-6: Continuing Faith Formation program**

If your child has already received the sacrament of Holy Communion, these classes are highly recommended as they form the perfect bridge between receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion and the start of your child’s formal preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation.

It is not unusual for seats to become available in classes once considered full.

REMEMBERING DEACON HECTOR COLÓN WITH GRATITUDE



Deacon Héctor L. Colón, 90, a longtime resident of Davenport, FL, went to be with the Lord on July 26, 2025. He was born on August 20, 1934, in Villalba, Puerto Rico, to Juan Colón Ortíz and Maximiliana Defendini. Deacon Héctor worked as a plant supervisor in the pharmaceutical industry for 20 years, retiring in 1988. In 1996, he moved from Puerto Rico to Davenport, Florida. In 1975, Héctor was ordained a deacon and served with outstanding commitment at St. Ann Catholic Church in Haines City.

Héctor was a man of deep faith, dedicated to the Lord, his Church, his community, and his family. As a deacon, he had the privilege of baptizing and marrying many people. He enjoyed reading the Bible at all times and always found peace and wisdom in God's Word. Héctor also enjoyed playing pool, building things—as he was very skilled—and working with his hands. He was generous by nature, always willing to lend a hand to anyone in need.

Héctor was preceded in death by his parents, Juan and Maximiliana; his son, Juan David Colón Olán; and his granddaughter, Karen Colón. He is survived by his loving wife of 72 years, Elsa Colón; his son, Héctor Colón Olán; and his grandchildren Kayla Colón, Carmen Colón, Zuleika Colón, and Héctor Colón.

The family will welcome relatives and friends for a viewing on Tuesday, July 29, 2025, at 11:00 AM, followed by Mass at 12:00 PM, all at St. Ann Catholic Church in Haines City, FL.

TRANSFIGURATION: THE SPIRITUAL LIFE IN MINIATURE

You were transfigured on the mountain, and your disciples, as much as they were capable of it, beheld your glory, O Christ our God, so that when they should see you crucified, they would understand that your Passion was voluntary, and proclaim to the world that you truly are the splendor of the Father. – Byzantine Liturgy, Feast of the Transfiguration, Kontakion.

The Rosary contains such power because it is a template for the spiritual life. Each time Our Lady leads us through the mysteries, we are united to Christ and led to encounter our own frailty. And the mystery of the Transfiguration is the spiritual life in miniature.

After six days, Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, “Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” He hardly knew what to say; they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; then from the cloud came a voice, “This is my beloved Son. Listen to him” (Mark 9:2-7).



In this mystery, Christ draws three apostles very near to himself. As in days of old, the mountaintop becomes a place of closeness with God. Like Abraham and Isaac ascending Mt. Moriah, Moses who ascended Mt. Sinai to receive the Ten Commandments, or Elijah's experience in the cave on Mt. Horeb, the disciples have gone up with Christ.

The mountaintop is a place to see clearly. In purely natural terms, climbing a mountain allows the landscape below to be seen for what it is. It's from the mountaintop that the terrain becomes clear.

Pope Benedict XVI says, “The mountain is the place of ascent—not only outward, but also inward ascent; it is a liberation from the burden of everyday life, a breathing in of the pure air of creation; it offers a view of the broad expanse of creation and its beauty; it gives one an inner peak to stand on and an intuitive sense of the creator.”

Christ does not reveal himself in a valley, but on a higher place. We must pour forth our own strength, even as we are moved by Christ's, to see him at the summit.

What was revealed to the disciples? Christ in all his glory. The Lord's humanity, during his earthly life, cloaked his divinity. But in this moment, the veil was pulled back, and the radiant splendor of his face shone forth. For the disciples, it was a vision as terrible as it was astonishing. It aroused fear, even as Peter voiced the desire to remain in that place.

But the spiritual life cannot be spent on peaks. We must descend. We embark on travels through the valleys. The mountaintop experience sustains us. As we face the valleys, we know the glory that awaits. The disciples never forgot that vision. Seeing the glory of Christ, they were able to hope in the Resurrection. In the darkest moments of the Passion, they knew because of the Transfiguration the true nature of the Lord of Glory.

NUESTRA PRIORIDAD ES EL CIELO



Una persona se acerca a Jesús pidiéndole algo inusual: "que le diga a su hermano que comparta la herencia conmigo". No era una petición de milagro ni una pregunta esencial sobre el Reino de los Cielos; Jesús parece haberla ignorado. Jesús ofreció una profunda reflexión mediante la parábola de un hombre preocupado por las cosas materiales. En cambio, Jesús le dice a la multitud: "Cuidense de toda avaricia, porque aunque uno sea rico, su vida no consiste en posesiones".

¿Qué hace a la gente rica? ¿Qué te hace feliz? ¿Qué te da plenitud en la vida?

¿Son importantes las cosas materiales? Pueden serlo. Necesitamos un lugar donde vivir. Necesitamos comida, ropa y un auto. Pero ¿son estas cosas las únicas que importan y son extraordinariamente importantes en nuestras vidas? ¿Determinan el valor de nuestra vida?

Pueden ocupar nuestro tiempo. Debemos ser cuidadosos con nuestras compras para obtener artículos buenos y confiables a un precio justo, pero tener estas cosas nunca debe estar impulsado por la avaricia ni el orgullo. Si compramos por avaricia, adquirimos más de lo que necesitamos. O lo hacemos solo para poder presumir de lo que tenemos, lo cual no sería la intención de las bendiciones que hemos recibido.

Para el hombre de la parábola de Jesús, el grano se convirtió en una señal de éxito. No es malo, sino un símbolo de progreso y éxito en Dios, que cumple un propósito esencial: proveer lo que necesita y compartir sus bendiciones con los demás. Estaba preocupado solo por el presente, con una visión demasiado corta, pero la pregunta es: ¿dónde estaba su proyección para la vida eterna? ¿Acaso el grano nutrió su alma? ¿Acaso ayudó en algo a su salvación?

El hombre murió esa noche. El grano no le sirvió de nada. Fue heredado por otra persona. El hombre pasó su vida enfocado en las cosas terrenales en lugar de las de arriba. Dios no influyó en su decisión sobre qué hacer con la abundante cosecha.

Agradecemos a Dios por todas las bendiciones que hemos recibido, pidiéndole que nos dé un corazón generoso que nos permita reconocer que lo que hemos recibido del cielo es para compartirlo con los demás y para su gloria.
