We are generally open 10:15 AM-12:00 PM, but in the extreme heat, we have been trying to open a little before 10:00 AM and close the parking lot at 11:30 AM for the safety of our volunteers. If you are coming for food, please plan accordingly.

In July, we served an average of 931 people from 207 families per week.

A GIFT FROM GOD



One of the best definitions of faith, for me, is in the letter of St. Paul to the Hebrews: “*Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.*”

We hope for love. Our lives always wait for tomorrow, which will be better in God. Even though we have our human limitations, we place our lives in the Lord, knowing that tomorrow will be better than today. Having this hope, we wait with patience for the Kingdom.

We see this in Abraham. God promised Abraham an “inheritance” in the Promised Land. Abraham immediately went as commanded, even when he did not know what would be coming, because he trusted God. Faith is accompanied by hope and goodwill.

The chosen people of Israel waited a thousand years for the new messiah, expecting that the Son of God would bring peace to their hearts. As they waited, many turned away to earthly treasures or false gods. Yet, many others kept the faith in hope.

Having hope can be a challenge. We might suffer severe illness, loss of job or other financial crisis, the injury of a loved one, or a devastating divorce. Through it all, Jesus is with us. Jesus may not avoid our problems, but He is with us through it all. Jesus knows what it is like to suffer.

When we suffer, hope can be hard to see. When we don’t get immediate results, we might want to take matters into our own hands. But the reality is that when we wait in our Lord and with the help of the Holy Spirit, we will be able to understand the will of God. Hope is still possible because Jesus died so that our sins might be forgiven. We need to be humble enough to admit our sins and to truly do our best.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

A VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR THE STUDENTS & THEIR PARENTS who attended class this past academic year, preparing for both the Sacrament of Holy Communion (May 2025) and the Sacrament of Confirmation (September 2025):

All students, regardless of whether they missed the first class, must attend the remaining classes through and including **Tuesday, August 26**, for those attending on Tuesday evening and **Thursday, August 28**, for those attending on Thursday evening.

Any student who misses any one of the remaining classes **will not be considered fully prepared** to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on September 13. Should a class be missed, the student and parent **will be called to a meeting** with the Coordinator of Religious Education to construct an intensive assignment that must be completed by **Thursday, September 11**.

CONFIRMANDI (Confirmation) RETREAT: THIS YEAR’S REQUIRED CONFIRMANDI RETREAT IS A TWO-PART EVENT!

PART ONE: will be on **Friday, September 5, from 5:30-9:15 PM**. At the conclusion, your children will be dismissed to the parking lot on the 10th Street side of the church nearest to the outside altar. Please park in that parking lot.

Students are to meet in the Narthex of the church and then attend the First Friday Mass at 6:00 PM. Students are to submit their completed summer project documents at the time of registration, which will be at 5:30 PM. If your child has not yet started this project, please have them contact the office. The project is extremely simple to complete.

We ask all students to come dressed in an item that identifies their favorite sports team, even if it is a team associated with their school. This can be as simple as wearing clothing or a cap that is of the same colors as their favorite team. They need not be an actual uniform item or replica.

Please do not come dressed in your “Sunday Best” as there will be some running and other activities that require comfortable, but church appropriate clothing and shoes.

PART TWO: will be on **Saturday, September 6**. This will be for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Please arrive by 8:30 AM at the church. Parents, please do not leave, as your children will be dismissed to go home once they have finished.

This offering of the Sacrament of Reconciliation is only for your children who have been preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. All others will be turned away and told to attend the regularly scheduled offering of the Sacrament of Reconciliation later in the day.

CONFIRMATION REHEARSAL:

The rehearsal for the Sacrament of Confirmation Mass (4:00 PM on Saturday, September 13) will be on **Wednesday, September 10 at 7:00 PM in the church**. Sponsors and those receiving the Sacrament must attend the rehearsal. If a Sponsor cannot attend, an adult “stand-in” must attend. The “stand-in” will relay the sponsor’s activities to the actual sponsor.

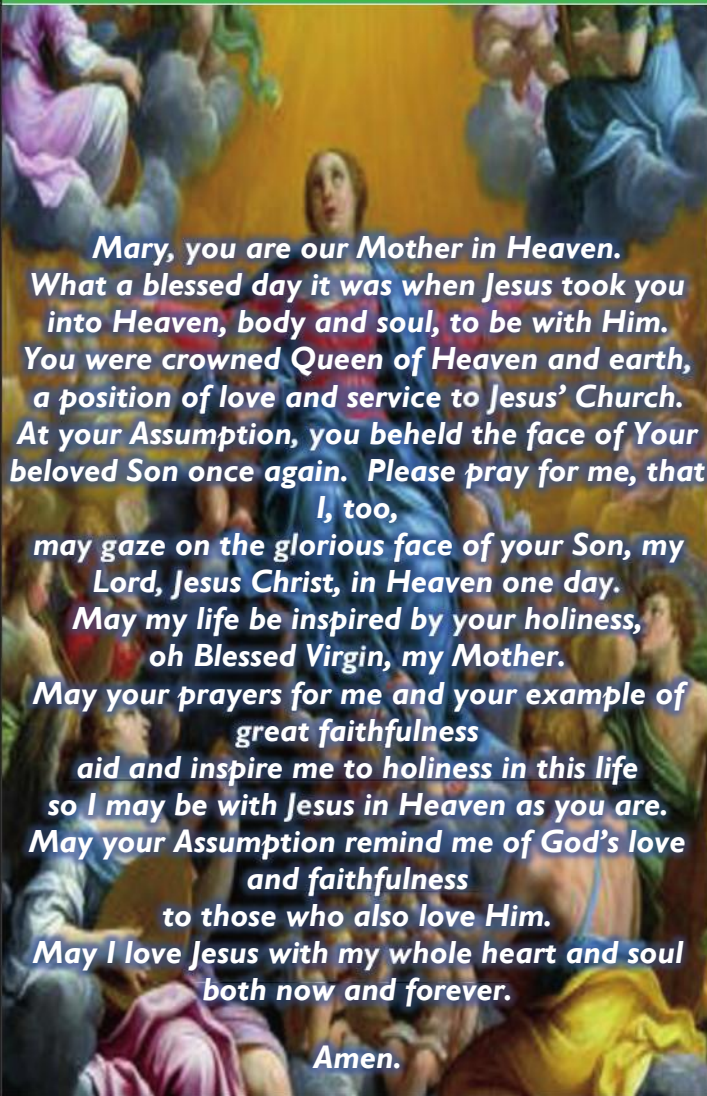

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: “We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory.” The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians, and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church.

We find homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century. In the following centuries, the Eastern Churches held steadily to the doctrine, but some authors in the West were hesitant. However, by the 13th century, there was universal agreement. The feast was celebrated under various names—Commemoration, Dormition, Passing, Assumption—from at least the fifth or sixth century. Today it is celebrated as a solemnity.

Scripture does not give an account of Mary’s Assumption into heaven. Nevertheless, Revelation 12 speaks of a woman who is caught up in the battle between good and evil. Many see this woman as God’s people. Since Mary best embodies the people of both the Old and New Testaments, her Assumption can be seen as an exemplification of the woman’s victory.

Furthermore, in 1 Corinthians 15:20, Paul speaks of Christ’s resurrection as the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

Since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus’ life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary’s share in his glorification. So close was she to Jesus on earth, she must be with him, body and soul, in heaven.

Reflection: In the light of the Assumption of Mary, it is easy to pray her Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55) with new meaning. In her glory, she proclaims the greatness of the Lord and finds joy in God her savior. God has done marvels for her, and she leads others to recognize God’s holiness. She is the lowly handmaid who deeply revered her God and has been raised to the heights. From her position of strength, she will help the lowly and the poor find justice on earth, and she will challenge the rich and powerful to distrust wealth and power as a source of happiness.

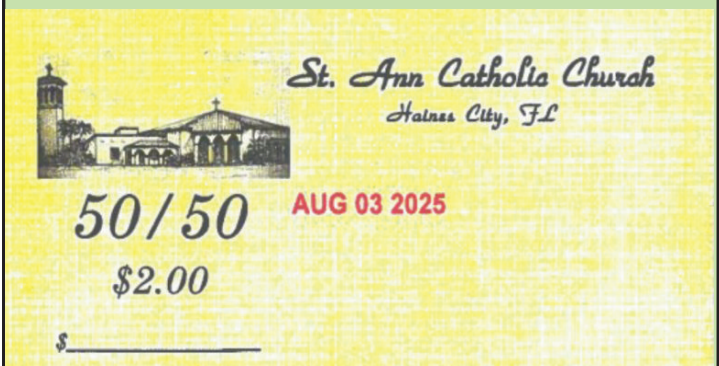

Pero la realidad es que cuando esperamos en nuestro Señor y con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, podremos comprender la voluntad de Dios. La esperanza aún es posible porque Jesús murió para que nuestros pecados fueran perdonados. Necesitamos ser lo suficientemente humildes para admitir nuestros pecados y hacer lo mejor que podamos.

PRIMERA PARTE: será el viernes 5 de septiembre de 5:30-9:15 PM. Al final, sus hijos serán despedidos al estacionamiento en el lado de la calle 10 de la iglesia más cercano al altar exterior. Por favor, estacione en ese estacionamiento.

Los estudiantes deben reunirse en el nártex de la iglesia y luego asistir a la misa del primer viernes a las 6:00 PM. 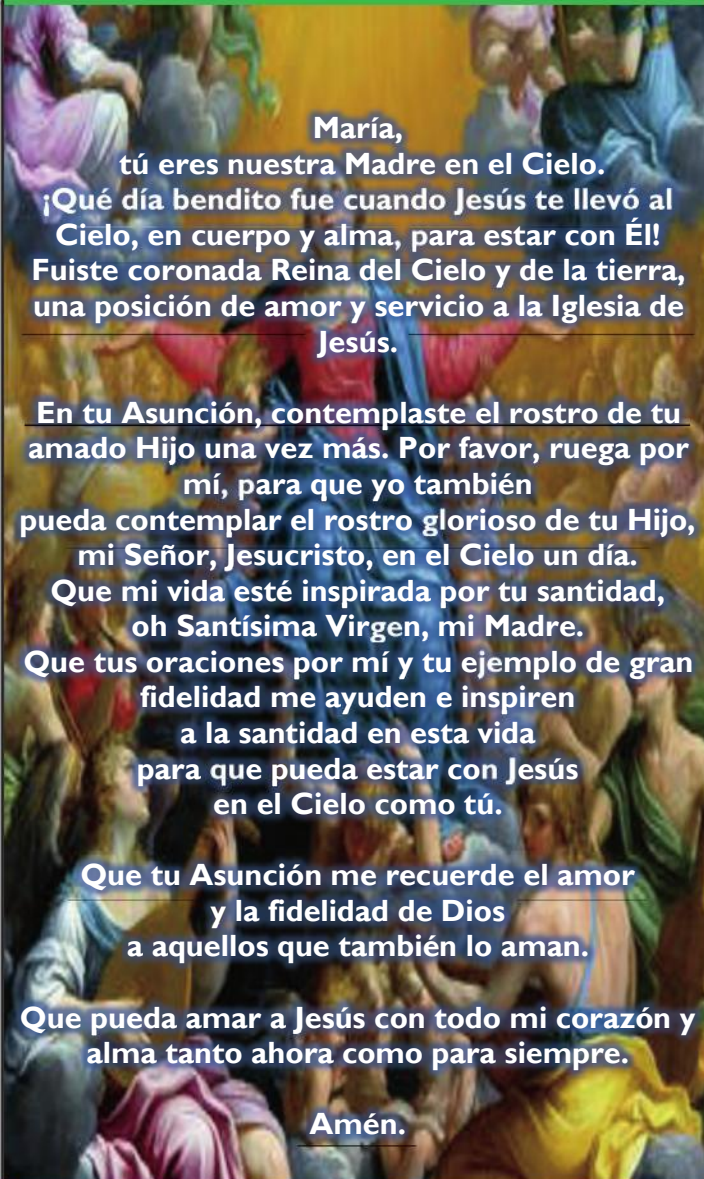

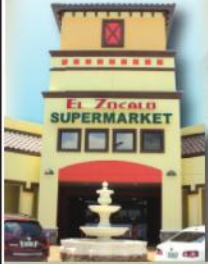
