ST. ANN YOUTH GROUP PILGRIMAGE TO ROME!



We are thrilled to announce that St. Ann Parish is sponsoring four members of our youth group who will travel to Rome, Italy, for the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati on September 7, 2025.

Our pilgrims are Isabela Gutierrez (18), Jayden Velez (16), Miguel Lara (16), and Elsa Lara (adult chaperone).

This is a historic moment for the Church. Blessed Carlo Acutis, known as the “Millennial Saint,” utilized his love for the Eucharist and technology to spread the Gospel before his passing at the age of 15. Alongside him, Pier Giorgio Frassati, the “Man of the Beatitudes,” will also be canonized, two young witnesses reminding us that holiness is possible at every age.

As part of their journey, the group will also spend a day in Assisi, where they will visit the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, as well as the sacred resting places of St. Francis and St. Clare. This powerful experience will deepen their encounter with the saints and their commitment to living the Gospel.

We invite our parish family to pray for Isabela, Jayden, Miguel, and Elsa as they embark on this sacred pilgrimage. May their journey inspire them to grow in faith and return ready to share the joy of the canonization and their spiritual experiences with our entire community.

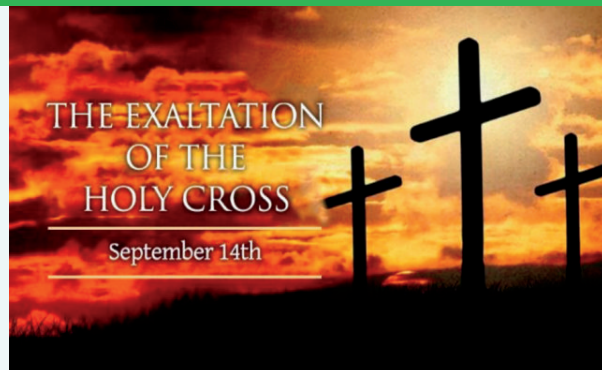
SAINT OF THE WEEK: THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

Early in the fourth century, St. Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, traveled to Jerusalem in search of the holy sites associated with Christ's life. She razed the second-century Temple of Aphrodite, which tradition held was built over the Savior's tomb, and her son built the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher on that spot. During the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman.

The cross immediately became an object of veneration. At a Good Friday celebration in Jerusalem toward the end of the fourth century, according to an eyewitness, the wood was taken out of its silver container and placed on a table together with the inscription Pilate ordered placed above Jesus' head: Then "all the people pass through one by one; all of them bow down, touching the cross and the inscription, first with their foreheads, then with their eyes; and, after kissing the cross, they move on."

To this day, the Eastern Churches, Catholic and Orthodox alike, celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on the September anniversary of the basilica's dedication. The feast entered the Western calendar in the seventh century after Emperor Heraclius recovered the cross from the Persians, who had carried it off in 614, 15 years earlier. According to the story, the emperor intended to carry the cross back into Jerusalem himself. Still, he was unable to move forward until he took off his imperial garb and became a barefoot pilgrim.

Reflection: The cross is today the universal image of Christian belief. Countless generations of artists have turned it into a thing of beauty to be carried in procession or worn as jewelry. To the eyes of the first Christians, it had no beauty. It stood outside too many city walls, decorated only with decaying corpses, as a threat to anyone who defied Rome's authority—including Christians who refused sacrifice to Roman gods. Although believers spoke of the cross as the instrument of salvation, it seldom appeared in Christian art unless disguised as an anchor or the Chi-Rho until after Constantine's edict of toleration.



CARLO ACUTIS, PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI TO BE CANONIZED ON SEPTEMBER 7



Pope Leo XIV announced that Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized together on Sunday, September 7.

Originally scheduled for April (Acutis) and August (Frassati), Carlo's canonization was postponed following the death of Pope Francis in April. While many observers expected it would be re-scheduled to coincide with the August date originally announced for Frassati, instead, they will both be in September.

Carlo Acutis: The "God Geek": Born in 1991 and passing away in 2006 from leukemia at age 15, Carlo Acutis has become one of the most recognizable Catholic figures of the 21st century. A passionate web developer and evangelist, he created a popular website cataloging Eucharistic miracles from around the world.

This digital devotion earned him the affectionate titles "God's geek" and "cyber-apostle." His tomb in Assisi, where he was beatified in 2020, has become a pilgrimage site, especially for youth and families.

His canonization was originally scheduled for April 27, during the Jubilee for Adolescents and Divine Mercy Sunday, but had to be delayed due to the vacant papal seat following the passing of Pope Francis on April 21.

Pier Giorgio Frassati: Joyful Witness in the World: Pier Giorgio Frassati, born in 1901 to a prominent family in Turin, Italy, died at 24 from polio contracted while caring for the poor. An avid mountain climber and activist, he is beloved for his dynamic blend of spiritual fervor and social commitment.

Beatified by John Paul II in 1990, Frassati has long been a role model at World Youth Day gatherings. His canonization had been informally set for August 3 to conclude the Youth Jubilee that will be held at Rome's Tor Vergata campus (not at St. Peter's). But Pope Leo XIV has opted for a later date, likely due to the logistical challenges of hosting such a large-scale event during Rome's sweltering summer.

A Moment of Global Catholic Joy: The joint canonization of Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati shines a spotlight on two young men whose lives speak powerfully to today's world—one immersed in digital evangelization, the other in hands-on charity and outdoor adventure. Their stories offer modern paths to holiness that resonate with young people and seekers alike.

These upcoming canonizations reflect a Church that continues to recognize holiness in many forms, digital, practical, intellectual, and sacrificial. As the world prepares to celebrate these new saints, the message is clear: Sanctity is not a relic of the past but a vibrant call to live with purpose, faith, and love today.

Entrar por la Puerta Santa de la Basílica de San Pedro, así como por la Catedral de San Juan de Letrán, Santa María la Mayor o San Pablo Extramuros, fue un recordatorio de que nuestra Iglesia está firmemente cimentada sobre pilares que permanecerán hasta la segunda venida de Cristo.

La gran característica de visitar estos lugares sagrados fue la alegría que llenó al grupo y la conexión espiritual con nuestros hermanos y hermanas de nuestra parroquia. La libertad que Dios da no conoce límites geográficos ni distancias. Nuestra comunión permanece y se fortalece en momentos como estos; somos una sola familia, y si la sangre es más espesa que el agua, el agua de nuestro bautismo es más espesa que la sangre.

Ahora, aquí estamos de nuevo en nuestra parroquia, llenos de gracia y bendiciones, compartiendo el fruto de lo que hemos visto y presenciado, para que juntos crezcamos en santidad. Un día todos entraremos por la puerta santa del Cielo, un día grande y hermoso en el que contemplaremos el rostro de Dios cara a cara.

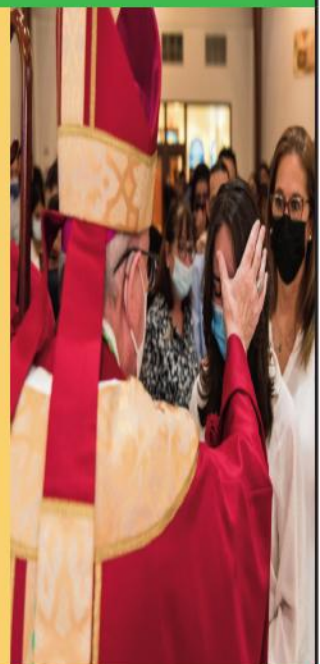

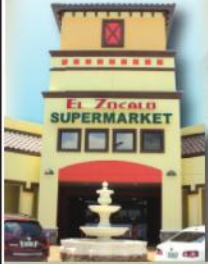
